Am I eligible?



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To be eligible to enrol, learners must:

1. Have at least one year of experience working on projects (this could be as a project manager (formal or 'accidental'), work-package manager, policy implementer, or other role in which you manage a component of a project).
2. Be an Australian citizen or permanent resident, or NZ citizen living in Australia.



How much time is involved?

- 12 training sessions, held 9am-12.30pm – all online
- 10 hours of pre-learning online content to prepare for training sessions 3-10
- 8 peer-coaching sessions (1 hour each) held weekly throughout Modules 3 and 4
- 4 assessment Q&A webinars to clarify what's expected


