

Case Study: Thales Australia

THE CHALLENGE

Thales Australia needed a program to upskill its workforce in project management while reflecting the company's unique methodology and the specific needs of the defence industry. The goal was to provide not only technical expertise but also soft skills like leadership, teamwork, and communication, essential for managing complex projects.




THE RESULTS

Elemental Projects collaborated with Thales Australia to design a customised Diploma of Project Management, integrating the company's internal project management methodologies into the course structure. The program included bespoke case studies, guest internal lecturers, and learning resources aligned with the defence sector's challenges.

The program exceeded expectations, with **100% completion rate**—significantly higher than the national average. Graduates reported high satisfaction, with **71% achieving promotions** or advancing to managerial roles soon after completing the course.



Case Study:

Sydney Water, Lendlease, and John Holland's 'Enable and Optimise' Project

THE CHALLENGE

Sydney Water, in partnership with Lendlease and John Holland, launched the 'Enable and Optimise' project to improve infrastructure delivery and leadership capabilities. The goal was a 10-15% improvement in efficiency across all KPIs.

THE SOLUTION

Elemental Projects played a pivotal role by combining formal training, on-the-job coaching, and gamified project simulations that leveraged ADKAR and the 70-20-10 learning models. These interventions enhanced leadership and technical skills for 200 employees.

THE RESULTS

- **92%** of participants started working in accordance with the new methodology within the first week after the simulation.
- **96%** of employees said they understood the new Management Operating System.
- System logins surged by **6,300%** from 2018 to 2019.
- All KPIs improved, including **12%** for safety and **10%** for community metrics.
- The capital program expanded by **52%** between mid-2017 and mid-2019, with minimal resource increases.

"This was a very different way to introduce the management operating system. I'd never appreciated quite how fundamentally important such a system is." - course participant.
